Requested Change:

The applicant is seeking approval to install additional propane tank cages. Pursuant to City of Coconut Creek Land Development Code standards and consistent with the previously approved Planning and Zoning Board site plan, installation of secure propane tank cages (cages) for the display and sale of propane gas tanks was approved within the outdoor garden center area. As proposed and consistent with applicants request letter, new cages will be installed adjacent to existing cages. Outdoor storage at any other onsite location is not permitted. Cages shall be maintained secure and as may be further required.

Further, it is the applicants' responsibility to ensure that all required permits are received prior to commencement of any work on site.
